SHORT on WORK 2014 – 3rd edition of the international competition of short documentaries on work. There is time until October 31st, 2014 to send your short documentary at '**SHORT on WORK 2014** - global short video contest on contemporary work – 3rd edition'

SHORT on WORK contest is a part of a broader research program of **Marco Biagi Foundation - International Doctoral Research School in Labour Relations** aimed at identifying new typological criteria – both theoretical and technical in the light of an interdisciplinary approach - of video representations of contemporary work, useful to enhance their use in research and teaching and to orient future productions.

'Short on work' global contest aims at stimulating and collecting new video representations of works and is open to audiovisual products consisting of a documentary whose length does not exceed **10 minutes**. Authors are invited to participate from any country in the world, proposing works that can be presented in any format in respect of the standards contained in the Regulations. Documentaries must be focused on contemporary work and its representations.

The Award Ceremony will be held in the Auditorium of the **Marco Biagi Foundation on 12th December 2014**. The Award Ceremony will be preceded by the broadcast of a selection of documentaries that take part in the contest.

The prize for the best short video on contemporary work is 2.500,00 euro whereas the second prize is 1.000,00 euro.
