The selection of the winners of "SHORT on WORK 2014 – 3th edition" is now occurring. The international competition of short movies on work is organized by the Marco Biagi Foundation– International Doctoral Research School in Labour Relations.

The contest "SHORT on WORK" aims at collecting and exalting representations of contemporary work and it is part of an interdisciplinary research programme, whose object is to enhance innovative ways of narration about contemporary work, especially through audiovisual products.

The international dimension of the contest is made manifest by the numerous and variegate works sent by authors from different parts of the world. Among more than 200 videos submitted the majority come from abroad: France, Germany, the United Kingdom, Spain, Romania, Portugal, Greece, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Latvia, Lithuania, Sweden, the USA, Canada, Russia, China, India, Japan, Algeria, Morocco, Egypt, Turkey, Iran, Brazil, Argentina, Dominican Republic, Bangladesh and Tanzania.

The Award Ceremony will be held in Modena on December 12<sup>th</sup>, in the Auditorium of the Marco Biagi Foundation, and it will be preceded by an international seminar entitle "Watching Work: an interdisciplinary approach".

The award for the best documentary will be  $\in$  2.500; for the second ranked documentary it will amount at  $\in$  1.000.
