



## **PRESS RELEASE**

On Friday 12 December 2014, at the Marco Biagi Foundation in Modena, during the seminar titled "Watching Work: an interdisciplinary approach", the 4th edition of "SHORT on WORK", international competition of short documentaries on work organized by the Marco Biagi Foundation - International Doctoral Research School in Labour Relations was concluded.

Among the 200 works in the competition, largely coming from abroad, the prize for the best short on work was awarded to TREASURE OF THE SEA presented by Astra Zoldnere worthy of note for "the capability to modulate, with different sequences and fields, a story with a powerful vision, rich of anthropological evocations, in which sweat and hard work are included in wider and playful social ties".

The second prize was awarded to AMAR presented by Andrew Hinton, a widely description of "an Indian guy's daily life, running among work-school-work, in his city. Amar gives us a paceful and intense tale, consistently rich of visual information, without dialogues nor narrators. The short opens a window on family and social relationships and on composites spaces that contextualize the day of the protagonist, organized and challenging".

Moreover, two honorable mentions were assigned.

The first one was awarded to LAINER presented by Anna Intemann and Dana Loeffelholz, an unusual work that tells the story of "a German unemployed going to China looking for a job. He finds it as laundry worker in a packaging enterprise. He isn't a "knowledge worker". He isn't a well paid worker. He suffers so much: languages, food, quality of life...everything is so different from Germany. Lair tries to adapt; it is unclear how much he does it. Overall, a very strange situation, without evidences of its nature of fiction. Clever. Provocative. Hopefully not prescient".

The second mention was assigned to Varvilla, presented by Valerio Gnesini, with the following motivation: "The representation of a great example of the binomial relationship composed by market systems and human relations, the basis of the fundamental connection between economy and society".
